

ESSAY TOPIC The words “ecology” and “economy” both come from the same Greek root — *oikos* (see application) — but over time their subject matters have become separated. Today, because of this separation, ecologists and economists see the world differently. But the economic health of society depends on the ecologic health of the planet.
